

One Year Retention Rates at Alliant

Alliant calculates a one-year fall-to-fall retention rate for incoming students.

This rate shows how many students of those who enter an academic program in one fall semester persist and are enrolled the following fall. These one year persistence rates for various program levels are shown below.
